System criteria	1858			Sales targets with measures for organic items shall be set. Performance and sales figures shall be documented in the action plan in the environmental report.
System criteria	1859			Annual food waste targets shall be set, and shall be stated in percentages. Performance and food waste figures shall be documented in the action plan in the environmental report.
Procurement	126		HO	The store shall prepare and regularly update a summary of organic items and other eco-labelled items.
Procurement	127		HO	The enterprise shall carry a minimum number of organic items and a minimum number of eco-labelled items, distributed as follows:  Very small stores (turnover below NOK 10 million): organic items: at least 30 items; other eco-labelled items: at least 20 items.  Small stores (turnover below NOK 25 million): organic items: at least 75 items; other eco-labelled items: at least 35 items.  Medium-sized stores (turnover between NOK 25–50 million): organic items: at least 100 items; other eco-labelled items: at least 75 items.  Large stores (turnover between NOK 50–90 million): organic items: at least 150 items; other eco-labelled items: at least 100 items.  Very big stores (turnover exceeding NOK 90 million): organic items: at least 200 items; other eco-labelled items: at least 100 items.
Procurement	131		HO	Eco-labelled, organic and fair-trade items shall be clearly labelled.
Procurement	132		HO	The enterprise shall carry a minimum of six items with a fair-trade label.
Procurement	1860			The enterprise shall carry non-food, eco-labelled items.
Energy	136			The enterprise shall reuse waste heat from its own refrigeration and freezer systems.
Energy	137			The enterprise shall use night covers on all permanently installed refrigeration and freezer units. These shall be permanently installed on new freezer units.
Waste	133	Section		The enterprise shall have regular routines for emptying containers of EE waste in the store.
Waste	140			The enterprise shall keep daily records of the amount of food items that have passed their sell-by date. Cases of theft and invoicing errors shall be excluded from these records.
Waste	1864			The enterprise shall prepare a plan for food waste reduction measures. It shall be able to document which product groups it will focus on. It shall prepare a list of measures for reducing food waste.
Emissions into the air	1863			The enterprise shall disclose its use of cooling agents in the annual environmental report.
Discharges into water	109			Grease separators shall be regularly checked and emptied, at least every six months, for example in connection with safety walkabouts.
